### 1. Equipment onboard

Items below shall be stored onboard. Please check and mark.

- Personal floatation device; Competitors shall wear it while on the sea, except an emergency
- Life buoy
- Bucket; at least 9 liters capacity with a lanyard over 4mm in diameter and over 2m long
- Anchor; no less than 3.5kg, with a chain over 1m long and over 8mm in diameter with a line over 30m long
- First aid kit; It shall be stored in either waterproof container or waterproof bag
- Manual bilge pump
- VHF radio
- One outboard engine with a minimum weight of 13kgs empty of fuel or similar electric motor with batteries of combined minimum weight of 13kgs
- Spare fuel tank; with more than 3 liters of fuel as leaving shore
- Equipment stated in a regulation issued by Japan Craft Inspection Organization.
